General Information

Type: Appointed by the SPL and ASPL

Term: 6 months

Reports to: Assistant Senior Patrol Leader

Description: Scout spirit has never been as high because of this person in the troop. He brings fun to a whole new high. This position will also include assisting the SPL and the ASPL for the troop.

Comments: Signing, dancing, sparklers and other spirit tasks will be called upon this person frequently.

Qualifications

Attendance: 50% or better over the past 6 months

Performance Requirements:

Training: Being this is an elected position this individual needs to be trained at the Junior Training.

Effort: You are expected to give this your best effort in this position as well as make the troop have fun.

Attendance: You are expected to attend 75% or greater of all troop meetings, Junior Leaders' Council meetings, troop outings and service projects. If your attendance is low, or if two (2) unexcused absences in a row transpire, you can be removed from office.

General leadership Responsibilities

Uniform: Set the example by wearing your uniform correctly. This means that you will wear all of the parts of the troop uniform, shirt tails tucked in, with all required badges in the correct locations.

Behavior: Set the example by being an active Scout and live the Scout Oath and Law as an example to others in everyday life. Show Scout spirit in everything you say and do. Obey and live the outdoor code. When spirit is low this person will be the one to lift the team up.

Attendance: Be punctual for meetings and activities. You must (call) notify the PL if you will be unable to attend a meeting or activity. You must ensure if you cannot make a meeting that the Patrol Leader will be attending and cover your position in your absence.

Specific Leadership Responsibilities

- Demonstrate Cheer
- Call upon patrols for their yell.
- Open and close events with that little bit extra.
- Teach the troop at least one new song.
- MC firebowl programs with the SPL
- Coach patrols for skits and other presentations as required
- Bring idea books and tools to troop events for skits and songs.
