Term: Individual Campout

Reports to: Patrol Leader

Description: He makes sure that the food is coming to the campout. He will work to develop the meal plan and get it approved by the Troop Grubmaster and purchase it prior to the event. He must work with the Patrol Quartermaster to ensure he has the Troop and Patrol equipment needed for the event as well work with the troop scribe to process the money for the food purchases.

Attendance: Be punctual for meetings and activities. You must (call) notify the PL if you will be unable to attend a meeting or activity. You must ensure if you cannot make a meeting that the Patrol Leader will be attending and cover your position in your absence.
