

Fish Fry Information

Location:

Directions:

Take M59 East to Williams Lake Rd
Turn Left on to Williams Lake Rd - going North
About 4 miles then turn Left on to Airport Rd - going North
About 1 mile then dead-end at Andersonville, turn right on Andersonville
About 1/4 mile turn left at traffic light onto Dixie HWY
Keep right on Dixie Hwy and drive slowly!
2nd right turn right onto Waterford Road.

There is a fish fry on the corner - this is NOT the place but DO turn right there

Travel about 1/4 mile on Waterford Road, dirt road, and the club is on the right - you will see the parking lot but not the building from the road.

Fish Fry Trunk:

There is a Fish Fry trunk. It contains the tip jars and lids, some knives to cut the cakes, and signs for the desert table. There may also be some paper plates left over from the previous Fish Fry. There are also sign in sheets used to track who attended and how much money was raised.

Please ensure someone obtains the trunk and transports it to/from the Fish Fry.

What the Scout needs to know:

Scout should be in the Class A uniform.

Scouts should plan to arrive around 5:15PM. We are normally finished around 8:45PM.

The Fish Fry officially opens at 5:30PM

Scout tasks:

- are to distribute the containers for the tips to all the tables,
- set up the carts used to buss the tables - they make sure they have buckets of water, dish clothes, place mats, trash bags etc.

They stop serving at 8:00PM, but people are still eating then.

Scout tasks at the end of the evening:

- tables need to be cleared, wiped down,
- tip jars should be collected and passed to the parents so the money can be counted
- salt and pepper shakers collected,
- trash bins emptied and clean bags put in them etc.

Parents tasks:

- set up for the desert sales
- Ensure the sign-in sheet is completed with the names of the boys attending, and the money raised, and how much allocated to each scout.
- One parent should count the money from the desert sales and tip jars, and look after it until it is passed along to the troop treasurer along with the sign-in sheet.
- A parent will be asked to take the trunk to and from the Fish Fry and hand it over to another parent for following Fish Fry.

Dessert Information:

- The desserts are donated by the parents
- Proceeds are applied to the boys scout bucks.
- Desserts are things like pies, cakes, brownies, cookies. We typically sell between 60 and 80 portions.
- We sell desserts for \$1.00 each so portions do not need to be really large.
- Homemade sells better than store-bought. We are routinely asked which are homemade items.
- Anything with chocolate is popular, and anything healthy does not sell.
- We slice the cakes and pies at the Fish Fry.
- Cookies either get set out on plates (say 2 per portion) or pre-packaged in zip-lock bags.
