Towel and washcloth / soap	Insect repellent ( <i>no aerosols please</i> )
Personal hygiene supplies	Sunscreen
Toothbrush / toothpaste	SCOUT HANDBOOK
Mess Kit / Utensils / Cup	Spending money (8 quarters)
Watch – Alarm clock	Trail food
Thermocup	Whistle / mirror
Water bottle or canteen
